

# CHERRY GROVE CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION BOARD POLICY STATEMENT

## TRASH POLICY

1. A trash container with a tight fitting cover, two handles and not exceeding 32 gallons in size and/or plastic trash bags not less than 1.5 mils in thickness which are tied or sealed closed are the only acceptable way to place trash at the curb. Trash container(s) shall be clearly labeled with the residents/co-owners address.
2. The trash container and contents may not weigh more than 50 pounds.
3. Newspapers must be tied or placed in the trash container or bagged and placed in a recycling bin (available from Canton Community Services). The recycle bin shall be clearly labeled with the residents/co-owners address.
4. Cardboard boxes, paper bags or store shopping bags may not be used as trash containers.
5. Cardboard boxes must be broken down and either tied or placed in the trash container.
6. Twigs, branches and brush must be tied with heavy twine. Bundles must be no longer than three feet, 1½ inches in diameter and must not weigh more than 50 pounds per bundle.
7. Carpeting must be rolled up and tied with heavy twine. Tied rolls must be no longer than three feet in length and must not weigh over 50 pounds per roll.
8. Trash pick-up is Thursday, unless a Holiday falls on Monday through Thursday; then pick-up would be Friday (unless a Holiday) then it would be Saturday. No trash collection is scheduled on the following Holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
9. Canton ordinance prohibits refuse from being placed out for pick up prior to 5 p.m. the day before your scheduled collection day.

**This policy applies to all co-owners, regardless of whether the co-owner is on-site or off-site. Off-site owners are encouraged to inform their renters of this policy.**
